












Background





Global trends in response to climate change

- •Climate emergency declaration and Urging global action on climate crisis.
- Carbon neutrality by 2050 as a global agenda, active involvement of global partners.
- Strengthening global environment regulation
- Introduce carbon border tax in EU and USA, and spread the campaign to join RE100.

Necessity of New Initiative for Carbon neutality

- New Global Carbon Neutral Initiative is needed, based on the examples
 of lessons learned from AWC on Asia's representative cooperation platform to
 address water issues in the region.
- At G20 Environment Ministers' Meeting, Indonesia and Korea shared the utmost priority for the establishment of carbon neutrality platform,


